## - Establishing a partnership to respond to the global climate crisis Agreement between Inha University's Climate Crisis Response Project Group and Ajou University in Tashkent

Inha University's Climate Crisis Response Project Group, Korea, and Ajou University in Tashkent, Uzbekistan, agree to cooperate to jointly respond to the global climate crisis and sign an Agreement.

Article 1 (Purpose) This Agreement aims to establish general implementation matters and close cooperative relations between Inha University's Climate Crisis Response Project Group, Korea, and Ajou University in Tashkent, Uzbekistan, in carrying out global climate crisis response projects.

Article 2 (Field of Cooperation) To effectively achieve the objectives of Article 1, the parties shall cooperate as follows.

- 1. Joint development and operation of educational programs to promote and increase awareness of climate crisis response in both countries
- 2. Joint development and sharing of training courses for human resources in response to the climate crisis between the two countries
- 3. Joint planning and operation of projects related to climate crisis response between the two countries
- 4. Joint operation and support of programs to utilize human resources in response to the climate crisis in both countries

Article 3 (Burden of Costs) Expenses incurred for cooperation between the two parties shall be adjusted and borne through mutual consultation.

Article 4 (Prohibition of Transfer) The rights and obligations of this Agreement may not be arbitrarily transferred or disposed of to a third party without mutual agreement in writing.

Article 5 (Effective Period) The period of cooperation under this Agreement shall be from the date of signing to February 28, 2026. However, if there is no particular objection, it will be automatically extended by one year.
