Articles are accepted in the following directions:

1. English Language Education & Pedagogy

- **Description:** This track welcomes papers that delve into innovative methodologies, curricula, and strategies in English language teaching and learning. Topics can range from curriculum development, assessment techniques, to addressing challenges unique to EFL/ESL settings.

2. Instructional Technology in Language Education

- **Description:** Submissions for this track should focus on the integration of modern technology into language instruction. This includes, but is not limited to, the use of edtech tools, platforms, and applications to enhance learner engagement, innovative online teaching methodologies, and evaluations of technological tools' effectiveness in language classrooms.

3. Korean Language Learning: Insights & Innovations

- **Description:** This track is dedicated to the exploration of the Korean language's teaching and learning. Papers might address challenges, pedagogical strategies, curriculum design, cultural integration, or comparisons between Korean and other language instruction methodologies.

4. STEM Education with English Instruction

- **Description:** This track seeks papers that explore the intersection of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) education and English language instruction. Topics can cover the benefits and challenges of English-medium instruction in STEM, strategies to integrate language skills with STEM content, and case studies of successful implementations.

5. Student Track

- **Description :** Are you a student eager to explore the fascinating world of language learning, teaching, instructional technology, and academic research? Then, our dedicated Student Track is designed just for you! This track offers a unique opportunity for students to actively participate in the Language Learning & Teaching and Instructional Technology Conference.

Requirements for articles:

- **Article Length:** Articles should have a length ranging from 3 to 7 pages, inclusive of references, and must be written in **English**.
- **Document Format:** Articles must be submitted in .docx format.

- Font and Spacing: Times New Roman font with a font size of 12 should be used, and the text should be set with a 1.5 line spacing.
- Margins: Margins should be adjusted as follows: 3.0 cm from the left side, 2.0 cm from the top side, 2.0 cm from the bottom side, and 1.5 cm from the right side.
- Title Formatting: The title of the article should be written in Capital Letters.
- Author Information: Following the title, please provide the author's full name, degree, workplace (including organization, faculty, and department), position, email address, and phone number. Use a 1-line spacing interval for this section.
- Abstracts should be limited to 100 words.
- Keywords should be included following the abstract.
- Bibliography and references should be provided at the end of the article, organized alphabetically.

*The submission file should be named using the author's first and last name.

**These requirements ensure consistency and clarity in article submissions.
